I met Tony Anthony some three years ago in Perth, Scotland when I attended a conference organised by the Perth Christian Centre of which he was the main speaker. The main content of the bible teachings being evangelism and the great commission.

I remember he taught on the urgency of Christians following God's mandate to fulfil the discipling of men and women to preach the gospel. There was emphasis on how all Christians can do this, the ways we can be encouraged to do this according to our abilities. He sited examples of the biblical apostles, also people who have done this in the past few generations. He also stressed how important it is that we follow the biblical apostles and modern day evangelists who are doctrinally correct.

The main emphasis was on equipping the saints for the work of the kingdom of God. The aim is to evangelise people or teach others if you do know, that you have the gift of the evangelist. He also taught on how we can all in our little way obey God in this most important course which is at the forefront of God's purpose on earth.

I believe he is a gifted speaker who can communicate his message effectively to people of all cultures and races. Furthermore, Tony is keen, enthusiastic and intellectually minded. With all these qualities he is still down to earth in personality.

He impacted my life personally by teaching the different methods of presentation of the message of the gospel. As a public speaker he brings to the community of Christians a dynamic way of preaching. Its through the penetrating way he presents the gospel that he displays insight and diligence.

His teaching materials and method was so effective especially the questions section of the meetings. I really felt at the time there was a need to extend an invitation to Tony to come and share these guidelines of the gospel presentation to the people of my region in Nigeria.

After about three years of planning, Tony was able to come to teach for approx a week on the principles of Evangelism in May 2013. I was Tony's host and spent those seven days with himself and a friend of his and a co-worker John Lawson. He is a very simple and lovable person.

The main emphasis in these conferences in Nigeria was to clarify the perception of Christians on what evangelism is and what it is not. These teachings have had great impact and opened up the understanding of the people and the concept of the Great Commission has now been given a better insight to the revelation of preaching the gospel itself resulting in the salvation of souls.

He went about doing this by teaching through energising power point presentations, tract distribution, practical street evangelism etc. the entire ministry team in Nigeria which is made up of people from several churches were very pleased with his in depth knowledge of evangelism and the input to their benefit on this subject matter.

Encouraging feedback was received from the people wherever he visited and this was from the attendees of the pastoral seminars, both prison inmates and wardens and the people from the villages that we were able to give our services. The various groups impacted were up to hundreds of people from the eight regions of the state. In one open air meeting alone approximately 250 persons made a decision to follow Christ.

Although there were great challenges during that trip, as some open air meetings were halted due to heavy rains, Tony's perseverance was evident as we all waited patiently together to take on any opportunity that came along instead of leaving the people behind in the venue. He was also willing to go to other venues that were not on the agenda before he left the UK for Nigeria.

I have also received recommendations from varies groups and they are very willing to accept him back to impact on the lives of the servants of God and the people in their communities the life changing message of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

The benefits of Tony coming to minister in Nigeria has been greatly appreciated and valued especially the aspect of spiritual activation/impartation of the gift of the evangelist in the lives of those whom God has called as there was a greater understanding of the gift.

Tony has absolute humility and reverence to the word of God in preaching the undiluted and doctrinal sound message of God.

Finally, he has the ability to go far beyond his present capability because of his devotion to prayer and selflessness in carrying the gospel of Jesus Christ to parts of the world that even cannot give to his ministry a re-numeration like ours in Nigeria. It is so great a sacrifice to make and I am grateful to know him as a beloved brother in Christ. Also his gifts and calling is recognisable and real, and the hand of God is on him.

His caring nature has extended from his natural family to the family of the Almighty God and I believe that he will continue to be a great asset to the body of Christ.
