My names are PAUL NZUKI and hereby testify that I have known TONY ANTHONY since November 2001 having meeting in BULLINGDON PRISON-(BICESTER).I arrived there in mid-November 2001 and at that time Tony was already serving a prison sentence.

When I arrived the first week at the prison I registered to be attending a weekly Bible Study Class and so when I attended my first meeting I remember meeting Tony Anthony and from that time we continued to meet on every weekly meeting for the Bible Classes and every Sunday service in the prison chapel. In the prison we were staying in different House blocks but we continued to meet during these weekly meetings, we got closer to each other and encouraged each in the word of GOD. I found Tony Anthony to be a sincere man very humble, caring, and supportive and he encouraged me a lot in the walk of faith in CHRIST. At one point he told me that GOD is calling him to serve him after his prison term, I remember Tony asked and invited me to be partaker of the vision.

A time come when Tony was released around January 2002, it was a very emotional time for me as we parted, while Tony was out he used to correspond and sent me Christian tracks to read, then in march 2002 I was released from prison and from that time we have remained in touch and also have attended one of his meeting in Colchester in2007.
