Dear Raphael,

This letter is a very long time overdue for which I apologise.

Back in June this year Tony Anthony came out to [redacted] as part of a wider German preaching tour. He arrived with us on 20th June during which he addressed a large number of soldiers and officers who were gripped by his testimony. That night he spoke at an open air BBQ mission event which was attended by in excess of 80 people and the following day he spoke in our local 'services' high school about his experiences as an author after which he took part in one of the local Regiment's military health fairs which was a great success. Tony spoke at a further event before leaving us the following day to continue his tour. His genuine humility, yet exciting testimony captured the imagination of those who listened.

Tony's visit proved to be a real boost to our mission outreach amongst British soldiers and their families in [redacted] and his book 'Taming the Tiger' has been highly sought after. Soldiers are still asking for more copies from members of our chaplaincy team.

In advance of the mission, your office kindly sent out well over 600 copies of Tony's book for which we would like to make some kind of re-imburement as well as send a gift for the work of Avanti. During the course of Tony's visit we took up an offering from among those who came to the BBQ which we have added a further gift from Garrison Church funds.

Current Charities' Commission regulations governing the control of military church funds prevents us from sending you a cheque with this letter, but I have arranged for payment to be made to Avanti by our central finance officer at Headquarters MOD Chaplains (Army) and those funds should be with you shortly.

It remains for me to offer you our sincere thanks and to Tony in particular and we look forward to working together with you again in the near future.

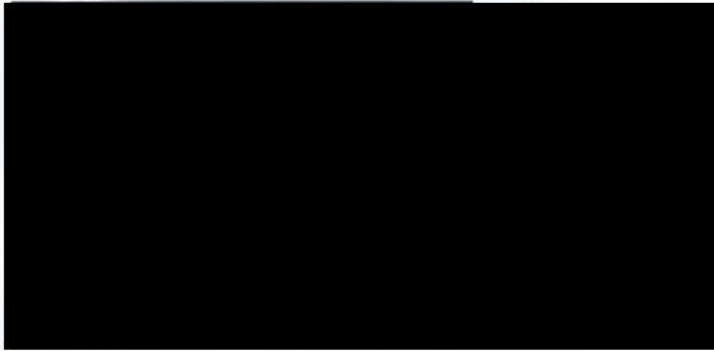

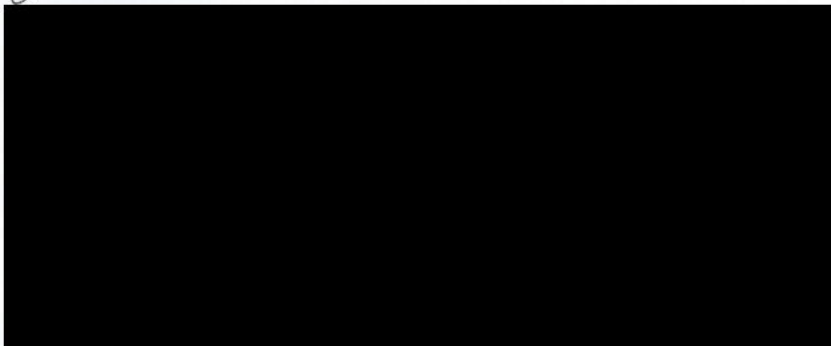
We will be recommending, this ministry to the Spiritual Care component at the National Office of Correctional Services for possible further interaction with regards to outreach programs and Anger Management courses.
